- The without notice originating application made by ANDREW JAMES
 BETHELL and ANDREW JOHN MCKAY of BDO Auckland and COLIN
 ANTHONY GOWER of BDO Christchurch on the 8th day of March
 2019 was determined in part by the Honourable Associate Judge Bell
 on the 12th day of March 2019.
- 2. The determination was made without a hearing.
- 3. The following orders were made:
 - (a) the convening period as defined in s 239AT(2) of the Companies Act 1993 ("**Act**") in the administration of:
 - (i) Arrow International Group Limited (Administrators Appointed);
 - (ii) Arrow International (NZ) Limited (Administrators Appointed); and
 - (iii) Construction Labour and Resources Limited (Administrators Appointed),
 - (together, the "Companies") be extended under s 239AT(3) of the Act to an end date of 31 May 2019, instead of 28 March 2019;
 - (b) the period of time in which the applicants are required to give notice of termination of a contract of employment under s 239Y(3) of the Act be extended under s 239Y(4) of the Act to an end date of 31 May 2019, instead of 14 March 2019, on the condition that the wages or salary that fall due during each administration shall be an expense of each administration under Schedule 7, cl 1(1)(b) of the Act;
 - (c) leave to apply to modify or discharge the above orders be granted to the applicants, and any person who can demonstrate a sufficient interest in the administration upon appropriate notice being given to the applicants;
 - (d) within seven days of the Court's orders, the applicants must:
 - (i) advertise the Court's orders in The New Zealand Herald, and

- (ii) post of copy of the Court's orders on BDO's website; and
- (iii) email a copy of the Court's orders to all creditors that received notice of the first creditors' meeting to each creditor's email address by which the Companies normally communicate with that creditor, or where an email address is not known or at the creditor's request, by posting a copy to the physical address by which the Companies normally communicate with the creditor; and
- (e) the reasonable costs of this application be paid out of the assets of the Companies.
