CCC (Rotorua) Limited (In Liquidation) (“the Company”) was placed into liquidation by special resolution of the shareholders pursuant to Section 241(2)(a) of the Companies Act 1993 (“the Act”) on the 17th day of June 2021 at 9:30 am. Thomas Lee Rodewald, IP 49, and Paul Thomas Manning, IP 39, both Chartered Accountants and Licensed Insolvency Practitioners of Tauranga, were appointed as Joint and Several Liquidators of the company. This is a solvent liquidation and will remain a solvent liquidation for the period of the liquidation. All creditors will be paid within 12 months of the date of the commencement of liquidation.

In accordance with section 255 of the Act we report on the Company's affairs together with our proposals for conducting the liquidation.


